
General principles

The device shall be mounted in accordance with the site layout plan or with the following principles:

- Secure the assembly site to keep others at a distance
- Designate a precise location of the assembly having regard to appropriate safety zones of all other devices.
- The device shall be mounted in consideration of an appropriate space of safety using of other, adjacent equipment, in accordance with the rules laid down in European Standard PN-EN 14974+A1:2010.
- During the assembly works, follow the original assembly instruction of the particular equipment.
- The item shall be mounted on a level ground, immediately after delivery to the mounting location.
- The installation shall be performed by using appropriate tools and technical means.

Assembly method

- 1. The assembly of the Bank shall start with planning of placing the device in area, having regard to its impact area (if determined) For this purpose use a tape measure, having regard to routes arround the item.
- 2. Screw the steel toe plate to the edge of the Bank by using 6 countersunk screws M8x14 and 2 screws M10x20 with washer M10.
- 3. Screw the side rails to the sides of the Bank by using screws M10x25 and washers M10.

3. Set the construction in the designated place, on a levelled ground, according t the figure below





Fig. 2 Concrete elements setup

4. Fix the additional element and Bank 600 together by using sheet metal plate and countersunk screws M10x20.






Fig. 3 The additional element and Bank 600 connecting scheme.
